Sub: To establish National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit at your premises.

Sir/Madam,

You are aware and some of you have been running NSS Units at your institute/ college. Since the last three years, we could establish 73 NSS Units in both University campus and 45 Affiliated Colleges under GGSIPU. It is further informed that NSS is considered to be included in all schemes and syllabi of all programs run by USS and its Affiliated Colleges of GGSIP University from the Academic Session 2021-22 onwards by the Academic Council in its 51st Meeting held on 11th August, 2021. **Two credits will be assigned under NUES for all successful volunteers who complete 240 hours of regular activities and seven day special camp activities** (outside the college - as per NSS Manual - (<http://www.ipu.ac.in/pubinfo/NSSmanual160418.pdf>)) during their course of study. They will also be given a NSS certificate on successful completion of the above conditions.

Now, NSS is considered as an elective subject (NUES) with two credits awarded on successful completion, students studying at your institution may like to opt for the same starting Academic Session 2021-22. Those colleges desirous of starting NSS Unit at their premises may apply in the **prescribed format** (<http://www.ipu.ac.in/pubinfo/nssnte080818.pdf>) under Self Financing Scheme (SFS).
