Known for its cutting-edge knowledgebase, the Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University (GGSIPU) functions with the explicit objective of facilitating and promoting studies, research, innovation, incubation and extension activities in diverse professional and technological domains of socio economic importance. It was established by an Act of the Govt. of NCT of Delhi in 1998 as a teaching cum affiliating University and has been included under Section 2 (f) and 12 (B) of the University Grants Commission (UGC).

The activities of GGSIPU are run through a set of 13 on-campus "Schools of Studies" created, evolved and maintained systematically covering the areas of Architecture, Basic and Applied Sciences, Biotechnology, Chemical Technology, Design & Innovation, Education, Environment Management, Humanities and Social Sciences, Information and Communication Technology, Law and Legal Studies, Management, Mass Communication and Robotics & Automation. The University also has two Centres of Excellence in the fields of Pharmaceutical Sciences and Disaster Management. It has set up an incubation centre to support Start-up and Spin-off companies. Through these Schools and Centres, the University focusses on a seamless amalgamation of research, innovation, incubation and teaching activities to enthuse, engage and train undergraduate, postgraduate students and Ph.D. research scholars in frontier areas of research.

The University is committed to provide all the requisite support to encourage its faculty, research scholars and students attain greater heights in their research, innovation and incubation pursuits. It has conceptualised and put in place enabling policies for smooth implementation of extramural as well as intramural projects, annual faculty research grants, student fellowships, travel grants and publishing grants, apart from infrastructural support for research to the best possible extent. The University has received grants under various schemes of Department of Science and Technology (DST), Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Science and Engineering Research Board (SERB), Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), UGC-SAP and DST-FIST programmes, Visveshvaraya Ph.D. Scheme, etc. The University has entered into memoranda of understanding (MoU) with many institutes of national importance, international institutions and industry for collaborative research and sharing of infrastructure.

There is opportunity to work at GGSIPU's research, innovation & incubation ecosystem and get benefitted from the GGSIPU's knowledgebase. The University invites postdoctoral fellows and researchers who have been selected under various schemes of the government, such as Ramalingaswamy Fellowship scheme, Inspire scheme, Women Scientists Scheme, or any other such scheme to promote research in Sciences, Humanities and Social Sciences to avail their fellowships in the University, and pursue their research in a University School of Study/ Centre of the University with matching research interests as per the norms and guidelines specified in their respective schemes and guidelines of the University.
