Project Saksham 3.O - a Legal Literacy And Legal Aid Project - is a collaborative initiative of USLLS-GGSIPU, Law Centre 1, Law Centre 2 of the Faculty of Law - University of Delhi, Jamia Millia Islamia, Jamia Hamdard University, Nek Mission Foundation and Naksh Foundation.

Saksham 3.O is curated with the aim to:
