IMPORTANT NOTICE

Subject: Guidelines for Admission under Sports Quota for various UG/PG Programmes offered at University Schools of Studies and Centers of Excellence for the Academic Session 2025-26

In pursuance with provisions of GGSIP University Act, 1998, the Board of Management on the recommendation of Academic Council of the University as per Statue 11 (2)(c) of the Statutes of the University, approved for the introduction of Sports Quota in the admissions of various UG/PG programmes offered at University Schools of Studies and Centers of Excellence w.e.f. academic year 2024-25

- 1. <u>Applicability:</u> The Sports Quota will be applicable to all UG/PG Programmes offered at University School of Studies for Academic Session 2025-2026, provided the Regulatory Bodies like AICTE, BCI, NCTE, COA etc., does not have any objection in the matter, wherever applicable.
- 2. Quantum:- Not exceeding 2% of the total intake of programme shall be earmarked as Supernumerary Sports Seat(s) for admission in Sports Quota in UG/PG programmes, offered at USS only. Further, in case of fraction of seats, the University will take the lower value so that the ceiling of 2% is not exceeded, e.g., say for 80 seats calculation of 2% comes to 1.6, is to be taken as 1 to ensure that ceiling of 2% is not exceeded.
- 3. Educational Qualification and Eligibility Criteria: Candidates desirous for consideration in Sports Quota are required to fulfil the minimum eligibility conditions prescribed for particular UG/PG programme(s) in the respective Admission Brochure 2025-26.

Admission under Sports Quota in Under Graduate Programme offered at USS.

- 4. Termed Category for Sports Quota & their Weightage thereoff for Under Graduate Programmes:-
 - (i) <u>Category A</u>: Admission without Sports Trial.
 - (ii) <u>Category B, C & D</u>: Admission on the basis of achievements in International/National/State level events and performance during the Sports Trial.
- 4.1. For UG Programmes (Category A) Admissions without Sports Trial
- a) Admission without Sports Trial: These are termed Category A candidates. The criteria for admission of Category A candidates will be based solely on the scrutiny of the uploaded/ Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate submitted by the candidate alongwith the Application Form. The candidate must have appeared in the applicable NLT/CET for admission to a particular programme. Thereafter on the vacant seats, the admissions will be carried out on basis of merit of CUET, wherever applicable. The allocation will be done on the

basis of fulfilling the common minimum eligibility, program-specific eligibility prescribed in the Admission Brochure and subject to availability of the seat pertaining to Sports Quota in the University Schools of Studies.

The allocation will be done on fulfilling the common minimum eligibility as mentioned in the Admission Brochure for UG programme and rank/marks obtained in NLT/CET/CUET, whichever is applicable.

Category A: Admission without Sports Trial

Candidate who have represented India in the below-mentioned competitions, recognized and funded by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (MYAS) will be given admission without Sports Trial for the Game/Sport.

- a) Summer Olympic Games by the International Olympic Committee (IOC)
- b) World Championship/World Cup by International Sports Federations (ISF)
- c) Commonwealth Games by Commonwealth Games Federations (CGF)
- d) Asian Games by Olympic Council of Asia (OCA)
- e) Asian Senior Championships by International Sports Federations (ISF)
- f) South Asian Games (SAG) by South Asia Olympic Council (SAOC)
- g) Paralympic Games by International Paralympic Committee (IPC)

Admission on the basis of Sports Quota for Category A will be based solely on the scrutiny of the Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate and order of the preferences of course / streams opted by the candidates in the Application Form. The allocation will be done on the basis of fulfilling the minimum eligibility criteria for a particular programme and in the order of choice-cum-merit of the preferences of Programme and subject to availability of the seat in the University School of Studies in the respective programme.

4.2 For UG Programme (Category B, C & D) - on the basis of Sports Trial

Admission on the basis of Sports Trial: These are termed Category B, C & D candidates. The criteria for admission of Category B, C and D candidates will be based on comprising 25% of weightage in merit of the applicable test and 25% weightage of the highest marks obtained by the candidate in the evaluation of Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate and the rest 50% of the highest score obtained by the candidate in the said Sports Trials.

For candidates in Categories B, C and D, weightage will be given on the Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificates in Application Form 2025-26.

- (i) 25% weightage shall be awarded to rank obtained in concerned National Level Test(s) like JEE Mains, NATA Score, CLAT-UG, CET conducted by GGSIP University and CUET (UG) conducted by NTA etc, whichever is applicable.
- (ii) 75% weightage shall be based on Proficiency & Skill merit, out of which:
 - a) 25% weightage based on the achievements after scrutiny of the Sports Merit/Participation certificate(s) uploaded by the candidate

and

b) 50% weightage on the basis of Performance in Sports Trial.

For candidates in Categories B, C, and D (admission on the basis of sports trial for UG Programmes) weightage will be awarded on the basis of Uploaded/Submitted merit/participation Sports Certificate in application form for the Game/sports.

Sports Trial (Maximum 400 marks)

Admission in Sports Quota Seats shall be based on team Games and Individual Sports, which shall be decided by the University as per availability of facilities in the campus.

The marking criteria shall be as under:-

Team Games

Basketball (M &W), Cricket (M&W), Football (M&W), Kabaddi (M&W), Kho-Kho (M&W), and Volleyball (M&W)

i. Fundamental Skills: 200 Marks

ii. Performance in Trial: 200 Marks

Individual sports:

Athletics (M&W), Chess (M&W), Badminton (M&W), Judo (M&W), Shooting (10 Meter Air Pistol & 10 Meter Air Rifle) (M&W), Table Tennis (M&W), Tennis (M&W)

i. Performance in Trial: Total 400 marks

A. Marking of the Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate (Maximum 200 Marks): 25% weightage in (Category B, C & D)

Criteria for evaluating/marking Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate(s) and displaying the marks for different levels of Games/Sports competitions is given below:-

- The Sports Certificate of Invitational/Memorial/Open/ Prize Money league/Selection Trial/Squad/Ranking competitions will not be considered. Letter/Letterhead of Merit/Participation in Sports competitions will also not be considered.
- 2. The candidates can upload self-attested copies of a maximum of three Merit/Participation Sports Certificates.
- 3. The Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate will be evaluated as per the Criteria for marking of the Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate. However, the highest marks obtained by the candidates in the evaluation of Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate will be considered for the preparation of the Merit.
- 4. Sports Certificate of the preceding three years only will be considered from 01st May 2022 to 30th April, 2025.
- 5. Incomplete/Cutting/Overwriting in the Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate will not be considered for marking under any circumstances.
- The level of competency of the candidate will be determined only for those who have achieved distinction during the preceding three years as stated in para 4 above in the game/Sport mentioned at sports category.
- The candidate must secure a minimum of 20 Marks in the evaluation of the Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate to be eligible for consideration in merit and for the Sports Trial/s.

Notes:

- 1. The candidate must secure a minimum of 200 Marks in the given Sports Trial to be eligible for consideration in the Combined Sports Merit (CSM).
- 2. The candidate shall be allowed to appear in the Sports Trial/s only in one Event/Weight Category.
- 3. The teams who are conducting Sports Trial should arrange for due video-graphy of the activity of Sports Trial without fail and preserve the recordings thereoff.

4. The Competent Authority, GGSIP University shall constitute the Committee for conduction and evaluation of Sports Quota admission of the University.

Seat Allocations

- 1. For allocation of seats for Sports Quota, preference will be given to Category A candidates.
- 2. For allocation of seats for Sports Quota to Category B, C and D candidates Merit of the candidates will be considered.
- 3. The Combined Sports Merit (CSM) score of a candidate will be summation of:
 - a. 25% of the highest Program-Specific NLT/CET/CUET score of all the Programs in which the candidate has applied
 - b. 25% of the highest marks obtained by the candidate in the evaluation of Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate, and
 - c. 50% of the highest score obtained by the candidate in the given Sports Trials.
- 4. Allocations will be done on the following criteria:
 - a. CSM ranking of the candidate.
 - b. Preferences of Program/Streams in the USS filled by the candidate.
 - c. Availability of seats for the specific Game/Sport in a USS opted for by the candidate.
- 5. In subsequent rounds (if any) for admission on the basis of Sports Quota, the Candidates who are already been admitted on a Sports Quota Seat will have option for 'Upgrade' to be considered for a higher preference of program/streams in the USS in accordance with the preferences filled by the candidate subject to availability of seats.

Important Information

- The Sports Admission Committee of the University shall verify the Uploaded/Submitted merit/participation Sports Certificate evaluated/marked from the original Merit/Participation Sports Certificate of the candidate. To conduct the sports trial, it will be the responsibility of the Director (Students Welfare). The Sports Quota shall be conducted by the Sports Admission Committee constituted by the Competent Authority, GGSIP University.
- 2. The grievance related to the award of marks of Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate shall be considered by the UG Sports Grievance Redressal Committee of the University. The marks of the Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate shall be displayed on the University website for three days to register the grievances, if any. All registered grievances shall be resolved within seven days by the Sports Grievance Committee of the University.
- 3. The marks awarded on the Uploaded/Submitted Merit/participation Sports Certificate which are displayed on the University website are provisional and are subject to final scrutiny and verification of the Merit/Participation Sports Certificate by the Sports Committee of the University. The decision of the Sports Committee of the University shall be final.
- 4. The University shall maintain a proper record of the documents of the candidates admitted on the basis of Sports.
- 5. The list (soft copy) of finally admitted candidates in the Sports Quota shall be sent to the Academic Branch within seven days of the last date of admission to the University. Academic Branch shall issue the enrolment numbers to such admitted candidates. Director (Students Welfare) shall notify the detail SOPs for admission to Sports Quota well in advance on the University website.
- 6. A candidate, as per his/her age must be eligible to participate in Inter-University competitions for the next four years and should not be employed on a Part-time/Full-time basis anywhere.

- 7. Any injury/casualty caused to the candidate during Sports Trial shall be the sole responsibility of the candidate himself/herself.
- 8. The candidate must submit an Undertaking at the time of admission stating that the candidate will practice and participate for the College, and if selected, will represent the University in the Sports Competitions as determined by University. In case the student violates the above referred Undertaking, the University has the right to cancel his/her admission.
- 9. All admission on the basis of Sports Quota are provisional and are subject to forensic examination/verification of the originals of Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificates of the candidate. Candidate submitting false/fake Merit/Participation Sports Certificates for seeking admission on the basis of Sports Quota, shall be debarred from admission to the University for three years. Such admissions will be cancelled and strict legal action will also be initiated against the student.

Admission under Sports Quota in Post Graduate Programme offered at USS

- 5. Termed Category for Sports Quota & their Weightage thereoff for PG Programmes:-
 - (i) <u>Category A</u>: Admission without Sports Trial
 - (ii) <u>Category B1, B2 and B3</u>: For candidates in these categories, weightage will be given on the Uploaded/Submitted Merit/participation Sports Certificates in Application Form for the Game/Sports mentioned in the application form.

Candidates who have secured Position/s in the All India Inter University Competitions/Khelo India University Games (KIUG) recognized by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU)/SAI/MYAS for all years of study in the UG programme for the Game/Sport.

5.1. For PG Programmes (Category A) - without Sports Trial

Maximum marks would be 100

I. <u>Category A:</u> The criteria for admission in this category will be based solely on the scrutiny of the highest marks obtained in the evaluation of the Uploaded/Submitted Merit /Participation Sports Certificate of the candidate in Application Form. The allocation will be done on the basis of fulfilling the common minimum eligibility; program-specific eligibility mentioned in the Admission Brochure and subject to availability of the seat in the University School of Studies opted by the candidates.

For candidates in this category, weightage will be given on the submitted Merit/ Participation Sports Certificates with Application Form for the Game / Sport mentioned in the application form.

Candidates who have represented India in the under-mentioned competition(s) recognized and funded by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (MYAS) will be given Admission in Category A on the basis of Merit Sports Certificate.

- 1) Sumer Olympic Games by International Olympic Committee (IOC)
- 2) World Championship/World Cup by International Sports Federations (ISF)
- 3) Commonwealth Games by Commonwealth Games Federation (CGF)
- 4) Asian Games by Olympic Council of Asia (OCA)
- 5) Asian Championships by International Sports Federations (ISF)
- 6) South Asian Games (SAG) by South Asia Olympic Council (SAOC)
- 7) Paralympic Games by International Paralympic Committee (IPC)

8) World University Games/ World University Championships by International University Sports Federation (FISU)

II. Category B1, B2 & B3: The criteria for admission in this category will be based on the combined weightage of 25% of the Respective Entrance Test and 75% of the marks obtained in the evaluation of the Uploaded/Submitted Merit/ Participation Sports Certificate of the candidate in Application Form. The allocation will be done on the basis of fulfilling the Common Minimum Eligibility, Program-Specific Eligibility mentioned in the Admission Brochure and subject to availability of the seat in the USS.

Maximum marks would be 100

- (i) 25% weightage shall be awarded to rank obtained in concerned, National Level Test(s) like CLAT-PG, CMAT, CAT, CUET (PG) conducted by NTA and CET conducted by GGSIP University etc, whichever is applicable.
- (ii) 75% weightage out of the highest marks obtained by the candidate in the evaluation of Uploaded/Submitted merit/participation Sports certificate submitted by the candidates.

The allocation will be done on fulfilling the common minimum eligibility as mentioned in the Admission Brochure for PG Programme.

It is mandatory that the candidate must have appeared in the concerned National Level Test(s)/ CET/CUET etc. as mentioned in para (i) above.

For candidates in these categories, weightage will be given on the submitted Merit/ Participation Sports Certificates in Application Form for the Game/Sport mentioned in category of sports. Candidates who have secured Position/s in the All India Inter University Competitions/ Khelo India University Games (KIUG) recognized by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU)/SAI/MYAS for all years of study in the UG program will be given weightage for the Game/Sport mentioned in application form.

Marking of Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate (Maximum 75 Marks)

Criteria for evaluating/marking of the Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate(s) and displaying the marks for different levels of Games/Sports competitions:

- The Sports Certificate of Invitational/Memorial/Open/ Prize Money league/Selection Trial/Squad/Ranking competitions will not be considered. Letter/Letterhead of Merit/Participation in Sports competitions will also not be considered.
- 2. The candidates can upload self-attested copies of a maximum of three Merit/Participation Sports Certificates.
- 3. The Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate will be evaluated as per the Criteria for marking of the Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate. However, the highest marks obtained by the candidates in the evaluation of Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate will be considered for the preparation of the merit.
- 4. Sports Certificate of the preceding four years will be considered from 01st May 2022 to 30th April, 2025.
- 5. Incomplete/Cutting/Overwriting in the Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate will not be considered for marking under any circumstances.

- 6. The level of competency of the candidate will be determined only for those who have achieved distinction during the preceding three years in the game/Sport mentioned at sports category.
- 7. The candidate must secure a minimum of 10 Marks in the evaluation of the Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate to be eligible for consideration in Combined Sports Merit and for the Sports Trial/s.

Games/Sports considered for admission on the basis of Sports

Team Games

Basketball (M&W), Cricket (M&W), Football (M&W), Kabaddi (M&W), Kho-Kho (M&W) and Volleyball (M&W)

Individual sports:

Athletics (M&W), Badminton (M&W) Chess (M&W), Judo (M&W), Shooting (10 Meter Air Pistol & 10 Meter Air Rifle) (M&W), Table Tennis (M&W), Tennis (M&W)

The Competent Authority, GGSIP University shall finally decide the game/sports which shall be considered for admission under Sports Quota for PG Programme before the commencement of Admission under this category.

Policy for the allocation of seats for admission to Sports Quota:

- 1. For allocation of seats for Sports Quota preference will be given to Category A candidates.
- 2. For allocation of seats for Sports Quota to Category B1,B2 & B3 candidates, the following Policy shall be adopted:
- 3. For the purpose of allocations of seats for Sports Quota, the summation of: 25% of the highest Program-Specific NLT/CUET/CET rank/merit and 75% of the highest marks obtained by the candidate in the evaluation of Uploaded/Submitted Merit/ Participation Sports Certificate.
- 4. Allocations will be done on the following criteria:
 - a. Preferences of Program/streams in USS opted by the candidates
 - b. Subject to the availability of seats in the University School of Studies opted by the candidates.

Important Information

- 1. A candidate's name appearing in the Sports Merit List does not guarantee admission in a program and the University. The admission of the candidate is subject to the availability of seats in a program in the University and shall also be subject to fulfillment of program-specific minimum eligibility criterion of the Department and as per University regulations.
- 2. The Sports Admission Committee of the University shall verify the Uploaded/Submitted merit/participation Sports Certificate evaluated/marked from the original Merit/Participation Sports Certificate of the candidate.
- 3. The grievance related to the award of marks of Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate shall be considered by the Sports Grievance Redressal Committee of the University. The marks of the Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificate shall be displayed on the University website for three days to register the grievances, if any. All registered grievances shall be resolved within seven days by the Sports Grievance Committee of the University.
- 4. The awarded marks displayed on the University website are provisional subject to final scrutiny of the verification of Uploaded/Submitted Merit Sports Certificate/ documents by the PG Sports Grievance Redressal Committee of the University. The decision of the Sports Grievance Redressal Committee of the University shall be final.
- 5. The list (soft copy) of finally admitted candidates in the Sports Quota shall be sent to the Academic Branch within seven days of the last date of admission to the University. Academic Branch shall issue the enrolment numbers to such admitted candidates. Director (Students Welfare) shall notify the detail SOPs for admission to Sports Quota well in advance on the University website.
- 6. The University shall maintain a proper record of the documents of the candidates admitted on the basis of Sports.
- A candidate, as per their age must be eligible to participate in Inter-University competitions for the period of study in Postgraduate program and should not be employed on a Part-time / Full-time basis anywhere.

The candidate must submit an Undertaking at the time of admission stating that the candidate will practice and participate for the College, and if selected, will represent the University in the Sports Competitions as determined by University. In case the student violates the above referred undertaking the University has the right to cancel his/her admission.
- 9. All admission on the basis of Sports Quota are provisional and are subject to forensic examination/verification of the originals of Uploaded/Submitted Merit/Participation Sports Certificates of the candidate. Candidate submitting false/fake Merit/Participation Sports Certificates for seeking admission on the basis of Sports Quota shall be debarred from admission to the University for three years, such admissions will be cancelled and strict legal action will also be initiated against the student.

The process of inviting applications shall be notified in due course.
