3.	Please clarify that one login id is sufficient to apply for more than one course	Yes, but you will have to pay the Application fees (Rs. 2500/- Non Refundable) as many time as the number of forms/ programmes/courses you are applying for.
4.	If I forgot USER ID AND password, how can I recover it?	Click on forgot password tab and click on forgot USERID tab.
5.	Facing problem in uploading of documents, what shall I do?	Upload documents in the prescribed format and size only.
6.	When, Online registration will be considered as COMPLETE?	Only after the payment of Application Fee of Rs. 2500/- (Non Refundable) and receive acknowledgement copy of the payment. After successful payment, take a print of the Candidate profile that shows the payment of Rs. 2500/- (Non-Refundable) with transaction ref. no. and date.
7.	When, online registration will be considered as INCOMPLETE?	 a) Candidate has initiated the process of registration, filled application details and uploaded required documents. However, he/she did not pay the Non Refundable Application fee of Rs. 2500/ In that case online registration is incomplete.
		b) Candidate made an online payment, but the payment failed. They did not receive an acknowledgement copy of the payment but the amount got deducted from this account. In that case online registration is incomplete.
8.	Information regarding Last date of Registration (NLT/CET)	Kindly refer Admission Brochure 2025-26 and also visit University Website regularly for notifications/updates in this regard.
9.	Can I appear in NLT as well as CET, where both options are available?	Yes, allocation of seats will be done in order of priority following 1. NLT 2. CET (subject to availability of seats) in the courses as defined in the Admission Branch 2025-26.

12.	How will candidate know about CET date and Exam Centre	The Candidates are advised that since the admit cards for the GGSIPU CET 2025 shall be made available to the candidate through the Online mode only, therefore he/she must keep the details of their login id and the password secure and safe

14.	Please clarify that old login id and password will be valid for Online Counselling Registration?	Yes, therefore he/she must keep the details of their login id and the password secure and safe.

Failure to produce a valid category certificate at the time of verification of document will lead to denial of claim in respective category. Thus, candidates not having a valid category certificate are strongly advised to change their category to GEN status during participation in Online Counselling process. Candidate not submitting valid certificate will be treated as General Category Candidate.

30.	Is choice filling necessary? What will happen if I do not fill any choice?	Yes, choice filling is mandatory. if candidate does not fill choice during the choice filling period, she/he will not be allocated any seat
31.	How many choices should I fill?	Candidates are advised to fill maximum choices as per his/her preference. The candidate should fill their choices in the order of preference and may reshuffle as many times as desired before locking of the choices. Once the choices are locked, the choices cannot be reshuffled.
