Subject: Mandatory Compliance & Monthly Reporting wrt BCI Circular BCID-1452-2026

Dear Sir/Ma'am,

This communication is to urgently invite your attention to the recent Bar Council of India circular **BCID-1452-2026** dated **11.03.2026**. We are required to ensure strict compliance with the directions flowing from the Office Memorandum dated 05.02.2026. This memorandum forwards the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India order dated 15.01.2026 in *Amit Kumar & Ors. v. Union of India & Ors., 2026 INSC-62*.

These directives mandate immediate and ongoing obligations concerning student well-being, suicide prevention, anti-ragging, grievance redressal, counselling, and gender sensitization. As the affiliating University, we must scrutinize, consolidate, and forward a "Monthly Action Taken Report" to the Bar Council of India by the **7th day of every succeeding month**. Therefore, your timely and accurate submissions are strictly required.

Please ensure the following actions are taken immediately:

1. Nomination of a Contact Person

- Please nominate a dedicated Contact Person for your institution to handle this compliance.
- Reply to this email with their Name, Designation, Phone Number, and Email Address by **3rd April 2026**.

2. Monthly Reporting via Dedicated Email

- All Centres of Legal Education must submit their monthly compliance reports directly to the affiliating University.
- To streamline this, we have created a dedicated email address. Please send all future monthly reports to: **bcicompliance@ipu.ac.in**
- Please note: To ensure we meet the BCI's 7th-day deadline, your institutional reports must reach us no later than the **3rd of every month**.

3. Institutional Publicity & Awareness Mandates

Every institution must ensure that complaint channels and support mechanisms are given wide publicity. You are required to:

- Prominently display the circular and institutional details (anti-ragging, grievance redressal, counselling) on notice boards, including hostels, libraries, and common student areas.
- Publish this information on your official institutional website.
- Communicate these details to students, faculty, wardens, and staff via institutional email systems and officially maintained messaging groups.
- Specifically inform all newly admitted students of these mechanisms during orientation or induction programmes.

5. Guidelines regarding The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace Act, 2013.


