Convocation Schedule


Date: 9th April 2026 (Thursday)

GUIDELINES FOR EIGHTEENTH CONVOCATION

All the eligible students are invited for attending the 18th Convocation of the University scheduled to be held on 09.04.2026 for receiving Degree of Doctorate of Philosophy, Gold Medal and Certificate of Merit, "in-person". They are advised to take note of the following important instructions for necessary information and compliance:

Prior Intimation: The students, as per list notified on the University Website, who wish their Degrees (in case of Ph.D. Scholars) and Certificate of Merit and Gold Medal (in case of UG/PG programme) to be conferred "in person", are required to submit **Consent form for Attending the 18th Convocation** which is available as Googleform, Link: <https://forms.gle/3Ku7UJStNJSDAiUa8> in this regard, latest by 4th April 2026 (Saturday) failing which the Degree/ Certificate of Merit and Gold Medal shall not be conferred "in-person" and they will rather be conferred Degree/ Gold Medal and Certificate of Merit "in absentia".

Admit Card: The Admit Card will be shared with the concerned students through email on receipt of details of consent on google form. **Students without** proper 'Admit Card' will not be allowed to attend Rehearsal and Convocation. Therefore, filling up the Google form within stipulated date i.e. upto 3rd April, 2026 is mandatory for collecting Degree/ Gold Medal/ Certificate of Merit "in-person"

Rehearsal: For orderly conduct of Convocation, a rehearsal will be conducted in the 'Auditorium' at its East Delhi Campus, GGS Indraprastha University, Surajmal Vihar, Delhi 110032 on 8th April 2026 (Wednesday) at 10.00 a.m.

All the Ph.D Scholars *and* UG/ PG programme **Gold Medalists** must attend this rehearsal, failing which they would not be allowed to attend the Convocation. The students must attend the rehearsal and occupy their allotted seats strictly as per "Seat Allocation".

Reporting: The Convocation ceremony will be held in the 'Auditorium' at its East Delhi Campus, GGS Indraprastha University, Surajmal Vihar, Delhi 110032 on 9th April 2026 (Thursday). Students must report at the respective "allotted Counter" established in the University on 9th April 2026 (Thursday) at 09:00 a.m. and mark attendance to get their seat number in the 'Auditorium'.

Convocation Angvastra: All the students will compulsorily wear Angvastra, which will be available for purchase @ Rs. 250/- only per person from the "Angvastra Counters" established in the University on 9th April, 2026 at 09:00 a.m.

General Instructions:

- Student should preferably wear formal Indian traditional dress.
- Only the recipient students accompanied with their parent/ spouse, (**only one person**) will be allowed along with the recipient student.
- Children less than 12 years old are not allowed.
- Students are requested not to bring any brief case, bag, camera, mobile phone, any electronic gadgets, matchbox, water bottle and eatables inside the University. Students are advised to make their own arrangements for safe custody of their belongings as the University will find it difficult to arrange the same.
- Students are permitted to enter the University Campus **through Gate No. 2** and park their vehicles only in the designated parking area.
