Other Item(s):

- 1. The Academic Council resolved that:
 - a. The admission of Ph.D. Programme shall be carried on a biannual mode.
 - b. Possibilities to be explored for establishing centre(s) of research for Ph.D. Programmes in the organizations having the necessary facilities and infrastructure to support research activities but not offering academic programmes.
 - c. Possibilities to be explored for relaxation in the admission criteria of Ph.D. Programmes for the working professionals, in consonance with the rules laid down by UGC or other Regulatory Bodies.
 - d. All the University School(s) of Studies/ Centres to review the existing programme(s) having admissions less than the sanctioned intake for further consideration in the next Academic Session.

Further, new UG/PG programmes which are industry specific/ skill oriented / in demand may be offered from the Academic Session 2025-26.

e. As per the National Education Policy (NEP)-2020, the scheme and syllabus of the programmes offered by the University School(s) of Studies/ Centres be reviewed regularly for the revisions thereof, if any.

Further, multiple entry and exit be planned for all the programmes under NEP 2020 offered in the University School(s) of Studies/Centre(s)/ affiliated institution(s).

- 2. The University should plan the Degree/ Diploma programmes to be offered to start Narela Campus from the next Academic Session 2025-26.
- 3. The issues observed during the admission process in the recent years to be identified and accordingly, necessary steps to be taken for strengthening the admission process for the Academic Session 2025-26.

The admission brochure of the University for the Academic Session 2025-26 to be released in first (1st) week of January 2025.

- 4. The University School(s) of Studies/ Centres should explore possibilities of collaborating with foreign universities for conducting Dual Degree programmes. A High Level Committee may be constituted for the purpose which may include Director (Academic Affairs), Director (International Affairs), Dean / Director of the concerned School/ Centre, etc.
- 5. The Academic Council also resolved that possibilities to be explored for constructing a Teaching Block for accommodating the increased number of students in the campus
- 6. The In-charge(s) of the *In-Situ* Centres established within the School(s) of Studies shall be invited as a 'Special Invitees' in all the meetings of the Academic Council.
